



MGUMC Ministries

As part of our ministry and outreach, MGUMC supports the following organizations: Alcoholics Anonymous (AA), Lebanon County Christian Ministries (LCCM), Gretna Glen, Disability Ministry, Mount Gretna Nursery School, Prison Ministry. Each upcoming newsletter will provide information about one of these ministries.

Mount Gretna Nursery School program for 3-, 4-, 5-year-old children is held at our church from 9:30-11:30 a.m., Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays from September through May.

Activities include science and nature experiments, art projects, music, finger play, cognitive games and book reading. The program strives to provide an enjoyable group experience for each child to better fulfill the potential God has given him/her.

The nursery school is currently accepting registrations for the 2024-25 school year. Tuition is \$195.00 a month.

Drendall Endowment

Each year since 2017, MGUMC has supported area nonprofit organizations with grants from the William Drendall Endowment. These grants have ranged from \$1,000-\$10,000 and totaled between \$68,000 and \$70,000 each year—and were made possible by Bill's bequeathing his entire estate to MGUMC.

Bill was a long-time resident of Mount Gretna and active member of MGUMC who sang in the choir, served on the prison ministry team and helped with whatever needed to be done. He taught himself bass guitar so he could join "A Wing and a Prayer, a contemporary Christian band started by MGUMC members. He also was a community volunteer.

A graduate of Drexel University, Bill worked in the nuclear industry. He passed away in 2016.
