MGUMC is Beneficiary of Gift

Our church has recently been blessed with a gift from the estate of the father of one of our members. The church member has donated \$50,000 to the church, with the following restrictions:

- The money is NOT to be used for on-going operating expenses of the church:
- The funds should be spent on ministries, projects and items that will promote the mission of our church;
- The donor would like funds used and not sit in a money market investment fund;
- The donor and family wish to remain anonymous.

Donations such as this typically are the responsibility of the Trustees. But because of the nature of the gift, an adhoc committee of members will be formed to consider how to be good stewards of this blessing and how best to allocate these funds. The committee's recommendations will be presented to Trustees who will review them and forward them to Administrative Council.

MGUMC depends upon members to serve on various committees that support our programs and ministries. Committees that are mandated by our conference include Administrative Council, Board of Trustees, Staff Parish Relations Committee, Nominations Committee and Finance Committee.
