# **MGUMC NURSERY SCHOOL EXPANDING FOR 2025-26**

Plans are underway to offer two week-long summer camps for current students and to add a 5-day/week option for those children headed to kindergarten in fall 2026. The additions were approved by both Administrative Council and Staff Parish **Relations Committee.** 

Shannon Fretz, nursery school director, will lead the summer sessions—one week in June and one week in July—providing an opportunity to keep friendships growing over the summer months. Campers will explore Gretna, visit the playground, go to the library, play with chalk and bubbles, do crafts and experiments—and so much more!

In the fall, the nursery school will add Tuesday and Thursday classes for older children to help them prepare for kindergarten. Monday, Wednesday and Friday sessions will be open to those children who are 3 years and older. Classes run from 9-11:30.
