BECOMING DISCIPLES THROUGH BIBLE STUDY


Consider Joining Our MGUMC Care Team

Solar Panel Update by Chris Sides

Since connecting to the grid on May 5th, our solar panels have produced 6.6 megawatt-



We have received our first rebate check in the amount of \$698.48 from the state through Act 129, a one-time rebate for investing in renewable energy. After some paperwork issues we were able to get connected to begin receiving Solar Renewable Energy Certificates (SRECS) and have received payment for three so far at a market price of \$26. Polluters must purchase these to offset their emissions from cleanenergy producing organizations. Additionally, we have been saving around \$200 per month on our electric bill and are expecting a federal tax credit in the new year of around \$9,300.
